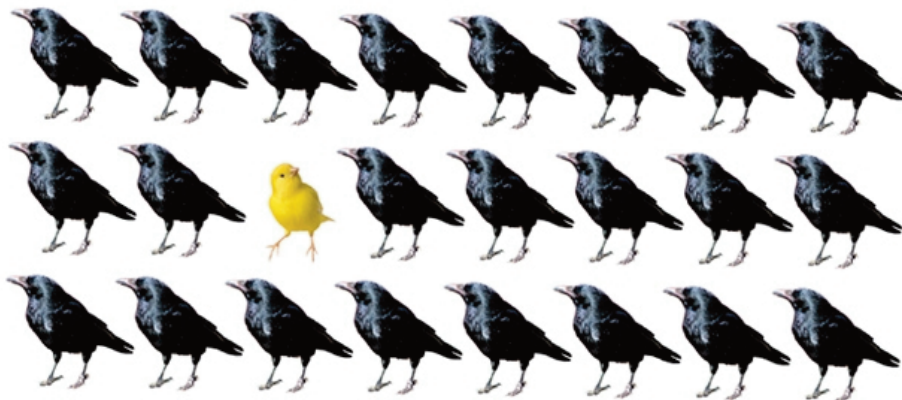


CANARY
